Background:

1 - July 12, 2015 Regular Meeting Minutes

- **2 July 2015 Financial Report:** The new budget for 2015-16 is in. This year I will be providing reports that will be on a Cash Basis. You will see the revenue posted as we receive it and the bills as we pay them. Moving over to a cash reporting system will also align us with the way our audit is being conducted. The marina fund has a revenue line for the Water system in the amount of \$525.00. This is for the water system that was billed out in June of 2014. The general fund, we paid for the new phone system in the amount of \$3107.11. The Annual dues are being paid for MCEDD and Chamber.
- **3 District's Financial Statements:** Nate Reagan has recommended that the Port switch the District's financial statements from the Modified Accrual basis of accounting to the Modified Cash basis of accounting. There are many reasons for the switch ~ mainly new governmental standards regarding PERS.

Recently the switch to use of the modified cash basis framework has been prevalent by small local governments because it offers benefits to the users and preparers of the statements. Here are other reasons-

- *The accounting records are easier to understand and maintain
- *Financial statements are easier to prepare with less reconciliations
- *These statements may be more understandable and usable by your Board and budget team
- *The statements will be more in line with your budget which is generally prepared on the cash basis

According to Nate, it seems unnecessary to require all small local governments to go to the expense of reporting their financials the same way as City of Portland or New York...? Long run this change will be easier to follow by the Board and should save in audit fees.

Proposed Motion: I move that the Port of The Dalles switch the District's financial Statements from Modified Accrual basis to Modified Cash basis, effective for the June 30, 2015.

4 - Baker Boathouses Moorage Fees: Kathryn Baker has asked the Port to consider waiving the moorage fees for the Baker boathouses located at C-18 and C-20. Her



reason for this request is the sea lion using her deck has become aggressive towards her, her dog and the housekeeper. Attached is a copy of the email conversation.

5 – DHS Lease: MVP Properties is managing the building where Oregon Department of Human Services (DHS) is, located across the street from the Port office. DHS is looking for some additional parking to accommodate their fleet vehicles so those cars are not taking up client parking spaces, and MVP asked if there was space at the Port that could be used. I had Jerry measure the gravel area North of the paved area, and it could accommodate about 10 cars.

Proposed Motion: To help meet their parking needs I would recommend that we lease DHS that space on a month to month basis for a fee of \$100 and require that we are furnished with insurance and liability coverage to satisfy our insurance agent.

STAFF REPORT

- 1. Monthly Highlights Andrea Klaas provided full report in meeting packet. Met with Lockheed, EPA agreed ORDEQ doing a good job, turned oversight back to them. Port needs to make a decision on whether or not to allow Lockheed to install a monitoring well in the parking lot; met an economic developer from New Zealand who is visiting communities in the US, Asia and UK. He was interested in a number of things we are doing in The Dalles. He will share his findings with us; Met with Samantha Julian, new assistant director for business development for Business Oregon. She has facilitated a letter from Governor Brown to Governor Lizumi in Tokushima Japan for Bob and I to take on the Sister City trip in August; Received notice to proceed from BPA. Crestline has estimated that it will take a week to get the job done then the final layer of asphalt will finish the project. Last step is to test the services that are being turned over to the City; MIDCO has purchased the Windseeker, looking for a restauranteur to operate;
- 2. Marketing & Communications Update: Kathy Ursprung provided full report in meeting packet. Land Marketing Work continues on the details of the Dedication Event; new slide video up on YouTube, Facebook and the website spotlighting beauty and other advantages of the area; upgrading the Website for a more attractive, streamlined and organized website; Marketing material our brokerage fee policy have gone out to the Mid-Columbia Realtors Association; First Cherry-Drop in Portland with targeted contacts in real estate and economic development. Wetland Regional General Permit TAC will reconvene on July 9 for the negotiation portion of the Process; May wetlands tours laid some good groundwork for this process. The results were documented in follow-up reports from TerraScience. Kirk Jarvey estimates we should be able to submit the final application to the DSL and COE by end of 2015, our goal is October. Weinstein PR Contract report included in packet.
- 3. Marina Update: Kathy Norton provided report in meeting packet. Increased delinquent activity resulting in the need to change the security code more often; ODFW cameras and other marina users have limited the amount of harassment of the sea lion; Request to change Marina Rules: #26 All persons age twelve (12) and under must be supervised at all times by an adult. #27 All persons age twelve (12) and under must wear a life jacket at all times while on Port docks.

Motion to approve the changes to Marina Rules #26 and #27 as modified. M/G.Weast, S/D.Griffith, motion approved unanimously.

2015-16 Moorage leases are out; Met with Ed Devlaeminck regarding the water system. Ed proposed Devco take over full operation and maintenance of the water system from now until March 2016. At that time they will provide the Port with an operations & maintenance plan. I asked Ed to provide me with an outline of what they will provide during this time and what will be expected of Port staff.

Background:

The office staff is taking a collective sigh of relief now that the big event has successfully concluded. Kathy Ursprung did an amazing job organizing and coordinating the day with backup assistance from both Kathy Norton and Jerry. The day could have been cooler, but it was nice seeing the turnout that we had. One fun outcome may be an organized quadcopter event on the property this fall. The local RC/Quadcopter club is excited to do something on the big, open expanse of the property.

Jerry and I met with Brian Thorne from Lockheed to determine a location for the monitoring well. It will be placed near the barn on the North side in the gravel area. I will let you know when they are planning on drilling. Brian said they are trying to schedule it on a Saturday to cause the least disturbance.

Some interesting Federal legislation: Sea Lion Bill Gets Hearing – A hearing was held in late July on H.R. 564, a bi-partisan bill co-sponsored by Representatives Herrera-Beutler, Kurt Schrader and Dan Newhouse, that would expedite the lethal take of voracious sea lions and allow the tribes to participate in the program. There were no surprises. Although supportive and calling the situation a "Bonneville Buffet", Ranking Member Huffman, (D-CA) also said the bill went too far and he would like some changes. The Administration witness also expressed reservations. During questioning, Congresswoman Herrera-Beutler took the opportunity to ask if the Administration had endorsed removal of the Snake River dams, noting how all the parties are working together to protect salmon and pointing out a number of coal plants would be needed to replace their generation. The bill remains in Committee.

The City and County both approved the Enterprise Zone agreement for Google. We are providing documents and information as required by us.

Floodplain update: Ben Beseda has been slow to get this moving because his contact at the US Army Corps of Engineers left. He recently has found the replacement person and so is picking this up again. We may handling the floodplain remapping request in two parts: First, getting the Crates Building taken care of then focusing on the rest of the Port land that may also be impacted by the floodplain.

We received our award letter for a \$20,000 grant from the Port Planning and Marketing fund. Based on this, we are kicking into gear discussions about creative ideas for the Klindt



Drive lots around business, public space, art, etc. Next week we are hosting a small group to brainstorm ideas to get this moving.

Bob and I met with Ray Bucheger and Mark Freeman as part of their annual tour the Oregon Ports. One issue that Ray is going to look into for us is where is the discussion about Forest Fires being handled as Natural Disasters? This is important to our region because if FEMA can pick up the cost of fighting fires, the Forest Service may consider re-funding the Oregon Invest Board and Washington Investment Board and region could receive it's final allocation of Scenic Area Funds for economic development.

G-2.) Marketing and Communications Update

Land Marketing:

Much of the marketing work over the past month focused on planning, preparing for and promoting the Up in the Air and Down by the River Dedication Party. We did some concentrated advertising in the local and Portland markets intended to make people more aware of the land available at the Columbia Gorge Industrial Area. The event was the subject of stories featured in *The Dalles Chronicle, Portland Business Journal* and *Oregon Business Magazine*, the latter two online. All of the local radio stations also invited us for interviews to promote the event.

While we continue to run quarterly ads in *Trade and Industry Development* and *The Gorge Magazine*, we are transitioning to a new phase of marketing focusing more on direct marketing targeting specific industries including Sporting Goods, UAVs, Food Processing and Wildland Firefighting-related business. We will be meeting with leaders in these industries, attending trade events and organizing direct mailings. We will also be organizing Fam tours where appropriate to promote our land and our community to prospects and industry leaders.

Wetland Regional General Permit

On July 9, the Technical Advisory Committee reconvened for the negotiation portion of the process between landowners, community stakeholders and regulators. As anticipated, the groundwork established during the May tours helped guide the group to a tentative agreement on a development and mitigation strategy we hope will allow for the development of the most valuable lands and protection of many of the most significant wetlands, and identified areas within the study area that could be used for mitigation.

Terra Science last week submitted a Development and Compensatory Mitigation Feasibility Report, which is a critical requirement if we are to apply for a Regional General Wetlands Permit, or a similar mechanism such as the Advance Aquatic Resource Plan, which was used in the Linn-Benton area.

Quite a bit of work still remains before we can file the application, including work with the Oregon DEQ on stormwater strategies. We hope to file by October, or the end of the year at the latest. Approval may take as much as another year.

- 4. Water System: Devco Mechanical has taken charge of the water system. When issues come up, I forward the information directly to Ed.
- Port Boathouse: All the material needed to relocate the boathouse has been received. As time allows Jerry is working to get the dock ready to locate the boathouse on the south east corner of A-dock.
- 6. The Hood River Double Damed Sailboat Rigatta is August 15, 2015. Some of the sailboats will spend the night at the Marina.
